DE SB 34 General- when a certified repair technician completes repairs to a customer's vehicle, the technician's best validation of the repair is to test drive the vehicle before returning it to the customer. Many times a customer's vehicle's registration has expired when the repair technician receives it for work. This bill will allow DNREC certified repair technicians to issue a temporary tag for the purpose of a test drive. The repair business must have a valid shopkeeper's or garagekeeper's liability insurance policy before operating the customer's vehicle.
