IA HB 112 Exhaust Systems- prohibits a person from operating a motor vehicle with an exhaust system that produces engine noise of 95 decibels or more unless the person has reasonable grounds to believe that the operation of the vehicle will not result in the vehicle's exhaust system producing engine noise of 95 decibels or more; also prohibits a person from modifying the exhaust system of a motor vehicle to produce engine noise of 95 decibels or more; provides that the decibel output of the exhaust system of a motor vehicle shall be measured at a distance of 50 feet in a manner that 1 complies with the standards and testing procedures established 2 by the society of automotive engineers.
