The rule changes are intended to clarify and update the rules to address current conditions in the industry, and incorporate statutory changes mandated by Public Law 37-2012 into the rules. These changes include eliminating outdated references to Indiana Code (IC) citations, adding definitions and references to improve clarity in the rule, removing the waste tire transporter manifest form from the rule, and updating financial assurance requirements. In addition to those updates, the statutory changes will authorize local government tire amnesty programs as another means to collect and process waste tires.
